The database is administered by issue-based analysts in AIA's Legislative Reporting Service (LRS), who monitor, analyze and report on priority legislation and regulations in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and the U.S. Congress, and provides information on the current status, effective dates, companion measures, key sponsors, and full text of bills, laws, insurance department bulletins, and regulations.

AIA Access is logical, intuitive, and easy-to-use. It allows you to search, sort and retrieve reports that can be printed, downloaded, and distributed easily. Other AIA Access features include a legislative calendar in chart format and wrap-up reports issued for each state at the conclusion of legislative sessions.

LEGAL RESEARCH, SURVEYS & CHARTS

AIA's Law Department regularly creates research documents and multi-jurisdictional charts and surveys on a variety of current property-casualty insurance topics. The information in these documents is specifically targeted to property-casualty insurers' interests, in order to provide them with knowledge and insight that is necessary to stay on top of industry developments. AIA's online research documents include comprehensive compilations of laws and regulations, analyses of specialized legal, policy and/or regulatory issues, and thorough scrutiny of current and emerging legislative concerns.
